### REQUIREMENTS OF HOST INSTITUTION FOR CESA STUDENTS

CESA nominates to American University qualified candidates upon the basis of their above average scholastic achievement and ability to do independent work. Applicants should submit the following: 1) International Student Application; 2) Official Transcript/Record of Grades (translated to English); 3) Nomination Letter/Letter of Recommendation from a professor or administrator from your university, or a job/ internship supervisor (translated to English); 4) Proof of English fluency: TOEFL 550 PBT/ 80 IBT (minimum score of 18 on the listening and speaking sections); IELTS 6.5; SAT1-Verbal 530; PTE 59; B-2 Level or Higher on Common European Framework; 5) Copy of Passport; and 6) Financial Documents:

a) Bank Statement/ Official Bank letter from a personal or sponsor's bank account indicating proof of at least the amount equivalent to the total cost per semester, on official bank letter head and translated into English and b) The Certification of Finances for International Students (CFIS) form found through the online portal.
